Mother's Day

John 19:25-27 Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene. When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple standing by, whom He loved, He saith unto His mother, Woman, behold thy son! Then saith He to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own home."

This is the time just prior to Jesus' death on the cross. Here Jesus is hanging on the cross, in pain and agony, and look who's standing right there by the cross--His mother! Mary and Jesus portrayed the perfect example of a mother-and-Son relationship. Mary stood by His side until the end and while hanging on the cross, Jesus made preparations for His mother to be taken care of after He was gone.

Mothers are a special people! J.R. Bookhoff once said: "Though a mother stays home and keeps her house clean, it is still not a home unless she creates the right spirit in the house. It is the atmosphere created primarily by the mother that makes a home worthwhile." Mothers have many responsibilities that excel that of


