II Corinthians 3:17 "Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty."

On July 4, 1776, the Declaration of Independence was adopted. This document was the written statement concerning the 13 original colonies' act of independence from the British Crown. It was a *declaration* of total freedom from the rule of Great Britain. This was the beginning of freedom in the United States as we know it today. Through the years, many have given their lives so that we could retain the freedom we often times take for granted.


