Remembering The Days Of Old

Psalms 143:5 "I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; I muse on the works of thy hands."

How many times have you just been sitting around pondering about the way things used to be? Maybe you were thinking about when times were less complicated (perhaps remembering when votes could be counted without a controversy). Maybe you pondered about when times were less violent. Maybe you pondered about when the air was cleaner, the streams were purer, and a day seemed to be a day long.

Many times we find ourselves delving into yester-year and longing for things to return to the way it used to be. Many things could be discussed in this category, but we are going to address a subject that deals with the Church.

How many remember a time when prayer was part of your daily activities? OK, now you can put your hand down. How many remember when Revival Meetings came to town, folks got saved and there was a stir in the city? OK, put your hand back down again. How many remember when folks used to find it a joy to come to Church, and while there, they would sing, shout, and pray around the altar? OK, leave your hands in the air, and praise the Lord that you can remember the *days of old*.

Many folks today have not been exposed to the *days of old*. They have been introduced to a *new day* with different standards, morals, and expectations. They have completed the *crash course* of religion only to find themselves lacking substance in experience. They have a knowledge of Scriptures but can't get the Scriptures off the page to work for them. They have learned formalities, only to find themselves faithless. They have become accustomed to a world that has prioritized everything but Church. Someone needs to stand up in this generation and shout "***I remember the days of old!***"

The days of old are not long-forgotten, some have just willfully forgotten. The days of old time revival is not past, old time revival is still just as real as we read about in the Book of Acts! The days of old time preaching has not dissipated, we are exposed to just as powerful preaching as was delivered on the Day of Pentecost. The days of old

time prayer meetings is not displayed in some sort of spiritual museum, it is something that is still just as real and just as powerful as it ever was. You see, the problem is not with the *old time way*, the problem is with folk's dedication to the *old time way*!

If we are going to have victory instead of just talking about victory, we are going to have to give our all to the One who gave His all for us! If we are going to have an unshakable experience with the Lord, then we are going to have to get an old fashioned experience with the Lord, where the Lord *is* Lord of our lives! ***Jeremiah 6:16*** says: ***“Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.”*** If you need rest for your soul, don't just think about the days of old, let the days of old come alive in your life.
