He Is Risen!

I Cor. 15:17-20 "And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins. Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished. If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable. But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept."

The validity of the resurrection of Jesus has been questioned by the skeptics and attacked by the unbelieving.

The reality of the matter is, the resurrection did happen! And as proof of His resurrection, Jesus appeared to many before He ascended back into Heaven. Jesus appeared to Peter and then the twelve disciples, was seen of above five hundred brethren at one time, James and all the apostles, and then He was seen by Paul also. With all of these witnesses, there is no room for questioning whether or not the resurrection took place.

Have you ever wondered what it would be like if Jesus had not arose from the grave? Well, Paul began to give some insight to those at Corinth. In closing, the world thought they had silenced the One who had torn their playhouse up, but that was the atmosphere on Friday, victory morning was just ahead! After three days and nights in the tomb, Jesus arose, and when Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to the tomb, the angel proclaimed, "He is not here: for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay." (Matt. 28:6)
