## **Seek THE Vision-Not Division**

Matthew 12:25-31 "And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself SHALL NOT STAND."

Jesus words here are as plain as it gets friends. In verse 30 we see "He that is not with Me is against Me"; and 31 Jesus further warns of blasphemy against the Holy Ghost which shall not be forgiven!

I mentioned briefly a couple weeks ago about Kentucky's state flag motto: "United We Stand, Divided We Fall"; this phrase comes directly from Ancient Greek storyteller Aesop in "The Four Oxen and the Lion."

In this tale a Lion prowls a field where four Oxen dwell. He tries many attacks, but whenever he gets near they turn tails toward one another so whichever way the Lion approaches he is met by one's horns. Bet the Oxen can't get along and separate in time by a quarrel! Each go off alone in separate corners of the field and soon are attacked one by one and all four destroyed by the Lion!!

Many scriptures in God's Word warn us about this division;

Saints we must be unified and stick together. Get on board with Christ's vision and the vision of our Pastor which is to see lost, hurting lives put back together; Let's reach out to the world and witness by loving one another the way Jesus loves us and living a Holy, acceptable life.

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 explains how two brothers (or sisters) is better than standing alone; if one falls the other lifts them up; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken!!!

Proverbs 29:18 warns that if we don't have this vision we will perish. So we must keep a clear vision and abide by His Word and stick together in love and unity (Ephesians 4).

One last warning in Matthew 7:15 tells us to beware of false prophets and the wolf in sheep's clothing; watch one another's back!
