It is better to "Shama"

1 Samuel 15:22 "Hath the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice. 23) For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry."

Shama in Hebrew means to hear, obedience, and listen! As children we all have to be taught what to do, and what not to do. Some things will harm us and some may destroy us.
