# Coram Deo

Revelation 4:11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

The Lord is worthy! Worthy of everything! Worthy of it all! Worthy to receive glory. Worthy to receive honor. Worthy to receive power. Revelation 4:11 reveals that the Lord created all things and all things were created for His pleasure. That means that everything is by Him and for Him! As we look in John 1:3, we find: All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. And Colossians 1:16-17 says: For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. So everything is about Jesus and for Jesus!

There is a Latin phrase Coram Deo, which implies "in the presence of God" and summarizes the idea of Christians living in the presence of, under the authority of, and to the

honor and glory of God. Think about it, isn't that what we as Christians must recognize—We are living in the Presence of the Lord--Everyday and every way.

We also acknowledge that we are under the authority of the Lord. Our life is not our own, we now answer to Him, live for Him, answer to Him, for we are under His authority.

And Coram Deo implies that we live to the honor and glory of God. We live to bring Him honor! We live to bring Him glory!

The world we live in constantly tries to mold us and shape us into their mold. Trends, fads, and, styles press us everyday. Friends, family, and co-workers press us everyday. As Christians, we must live with the idea of Coram Deo--We live in His presence, under His authority and live to the honor and glory of God.
