In The Night Seasons

Psalms 16:7 "I will bless the LORD, who hath given me counsel: my reins also instruct me in the night seasons."

The Psalmist David was a man well acquainted with the seasons of life. David had been through seasons of great triumph as well as seasons of great defeat. It was through these seasons that David leaned upon the Lord! You see, David knew that since the Lord had the power to change natural seasons, He had the power to change his seasons.

In this particular passage of Scripture, David was talking about *night seasons*. When you look up the Hebrew translation

of night in this Scripture, you find that it means: a twist (away of the light), i.e. night; fig. adversity:--([mid-]) night (season) (Strongs).

One of the most chilling experiences one can encounter is that of total darkness. If you've ever been in a place such as a cave or coal mine, or some room where no light could enter in, you found it to be a place of profound darkness-darkness that leaves you totally without direction-darkness that leaves you uncertain of your next step.


