Separation From The World The Response To The Command

II Corinthians 6:14-18 “Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? And what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? Or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? For ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.”

Throughout the Bible, God's people have always been called to a separation from the world. That call came in their lifestyles, their religion, and their journeys. Separation from the world and its views, ideals, and behavior is what makes God's people a separate people that stand out from the norms of society.

The society that we live in has all but erased that line of separation that God has always intended for His people to recognize. An effort is being made today to erase, or at least blur the line of separation between the saved and the unsaved, the moral and the immoral, right and wrong, good and evil, and what is acceptable and what is unacceptable.

We must come to terms that an attack on the very essence of Christianity is being launched by the devil and those he has deceived

The word beguile is translated from a Hebrew word that means to lead astray, such as to mentally, to delude, or lead astray morally, to seduce. The devil messed with Eve's mind and her better judgment when he said: "...Ye shall not surely die..."

The devil is trying to mentally delude this generation. He is confusing young people and messing with the minds of folks to where deception has reached epidemic proportions. We are living in a time of spiritual and natural seduction whose grip is becoming firmer as moral fibers unravel. We have sin taking the forefront as Christians take the back seat. We have sin boasting as the saved sulk. The voice of sin is being lifted up, while the voice of triumph is fading in the background. It's time to stand up in this dark and perverse world and proclaim the right to the wrong, the good to the evil, the moral to the immoral, and let this generation know what is acceptable and what is not acceptable behavior in the eyes of the Lord.

In closing, this generation is depending upon you to hold the torch of holiness and separation high in the air and carry this torch boldly so that souls might be saved. Eternity cannot be reduced to a guessing game or a game of chance. You have only one chance to make it to Heaven. There will be no make up exams, if you miss Heaven, you won't have a second chance.

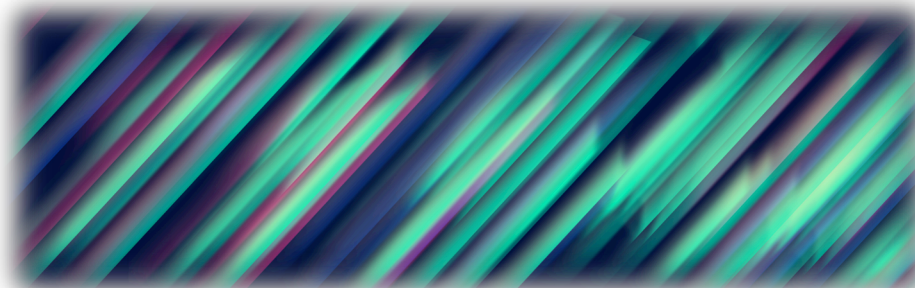
