CAC 22nd Anniversary

Cornerstone Apostolic Church was founded with a call and a vision to be a place where the lost, the hurting, and the backslider could come and find salvation, healing, and restoration. With about 11 people, we set out to find a place where we could begin this new work. We found and rented a vacant brick church building located on US Highway 460 East at Mouthcard, Kentucky, which was located about 22 miles from our present location. This building was fully furnished and ready to start having services in, and it also met our budget that we had at that time. This building would be the home of CAC for the next 14 months.

On our very first service, we had 94 people in attendance and one person started praying, as this would prove to be the beginning of many

wonderful things to come. In the weeks that followed, someone was either giving their life to the Lord or getting baptized. The Lord was abundantly blessing our humble beginnings.

As we continued to grow, we knew we needed more than a rented building, we needed a permanent place to establish the work God had called us to do. We found a tract of land at Mouthcard, Kentucky and a tract of land at Jamboree, Kentucky. After presenting them before the Church, we felt the Lord had directed us to purchase the land at Jamboree, Kentucky to be the permanent home of Cornerstone Apostolic Church.

We had ground breaking on May 9, 1998 with about 35 or 40 in attendance. We then entered into a building program to build a building 40' x 104' that would have Cathedral Ceilings in the Sanctuary, a Balcony in the back, an upstairs and downstairs in the back, 5 Sunday School Rooms, Kitchen/Dining Area, two handicap accessible restrooms, a heated Baptistry, paved parking area, and a seating capacity of approximately 190 people. Within 4 months from Ground

Breaking, we had our first service in the finished Sanctuary on September 27, 1998. After a few services in the new building, we held our Dedication Service on October 18, 1998. Our record attendance was set during those Dedication Services with 175 in attendance.

Since that Dedication Service, we have purchased two houses, two more tracts of land that adjoined our existing campus, made many renovations and expansions with the addition of the C.A.C.Y. Wing a 40' x 60' wing to facilitate Children's Church and additional Sunday School rooms, with the lower level hosting our dining space. This is made possible only by the blessings of the Lord and the dedication and tenacity of God's people.

Our vision includes a Christian School with a regulation size gymnasium and a Day Care Center. We feel the Christian School will bless kids both Biblically and Academically. With the Day Care, making it possible for single parents to beat the bondage of poverty and go to work having a safe place to leave their child.

So today, we celebrate 22 years of being together at Cornerstone Apostolic Church.
