## Mirrors And Commandments

**John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.**

So you just broke a mirror. Maybe you were hanging it and it slipped out of your hands. Maybe you were cleaning it and it

fell from the nail it was hanging on, or perhaps you were throwing it away and as you tossed it in the trash you hear the sound of shattering glass. Now what? Oh no, are you going to have seven years of bad luck? Is there some hardship going to be placed upon you or your family because of reflective glass being shattered? After all, we have all heard that it will bring seven years of bad luck if you break a mirror. Well, the truth is, breaking a mirror has nothing to do with what happens to you now or in the future. (Unless it was your Momma's favorite one and she tans your hide for breaking it).

What we should really be worried about is breaking God's Commandments. When Jesus was confronted by the rich young ruler, in Matthew 19:16-17, He was asked, "...Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?" Jesus replied in verse 17 "And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments."

When we break or don't keep God's Commandments we place ourselves in a dangerous situation. We have just placed ourselves in a losing lifestyle. The only way we can hope for God's mercy is if we truly repent and then keep His

Commandments. Unrepentant when it comes to Breaking the Commandments of the Lord will result in us facing the consequences of our actions, not for seven years, but for eternity.

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 says, "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. 14 For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil."

So if you have broken a mirror, don't sweat it, go out and buy another one and go on with your next seven years, but if you have broken God's commandments, stop what you are doing and repent for the outcome of broken Commandments eternally outweigh the temporary consequences of a broken mirror.
