### Leadership And Ministry

**Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.**

Leadership is defined as: *the act or an instance of leading; the power or ability to lead others.* To be a leader, you have to show the ability to focus on others. You cannot be a true leader if you are self-centered or egocentric. John Maxwell in his book *Developing The Leader Within You*, says “...Everything rises and falls on leadership...”. and “...your leadership skills determine the level of your success...”. Understanding our leadership abilities will help us to utilize our strengths and work on our weakness.

Leaders have to want to lead. A good leader will help others excel. A good leader will inspire others. A good leader will be faithful. But a person who is in a leadership position because they like the title, enjoy the attention, or feed on the accolades, will hinder a company, team, or church. Leaders have to be selfless and sacrificial.

Let's now look at ministry. Ministry is defined as: *to give aid or service to help someone or to do religious work.*

Ministry workers have to want to minister. They must realize that their purpose is to help others become better people, better Christians, better workers, and inspire others to get closer to the

Lord. Ministry workers must be faithful, selfless, and sacrificial, But a person who is in a ministry position because they like the office, the title, the attention, or feed on the accolades, will do nothing but hinder the work of a Church and others. Jesus talked about a people who caused such hindrances in Matthew 23:13 “But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.” The scribes, Pharisees, and hypocrites were folks who hindered people while in their position of ministry!

If you desire to be a leader and work in ministry, you must enter the position knowing the expectations of Lord, the Church you attend, and the Pastor you sit under. You must realize the sacrifice that will be required of you and your time. You must realize the commitment and faithfulness it will take to be a leader and minister in Sunday School, Youth Service, Music Department, Praise Team, Chorale, Pulpit Ministry, or anything your hand finds to do to help others. Ecclesiastes 9:10 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.
