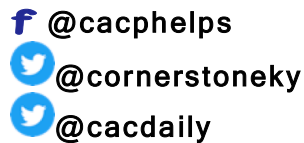

### Constant

**Proverbs 24:21-22 My son, fear thou the Lord and the king: and meddle not with them that are given to change: 22 For their calamity shall rise suddenly; and who knoweth the ruin of them both?**

Have you ever met someone who is always changing his or her mind? Have you seen folks who are always changing jobs? Have you witnessed people who

keep changing wives? Have you observed people who are always changing churches? Now that you have thought upon these questions, would you want to follow these people?

If someone is always changing their mind, and you follow them, you will stand for one thing today and something else tomorrow. If you follow someone who is always changing jobs, you will never receive a retirement. If you are caught up in friendships that struggle being faithful to their spouse, you will find it a struggle to stay faithful to your spouse. And if people who are always changing churches influence you, you will never get established in a Truth-based, godly environment for you and your family.

The Bible tells us to not *meddle* with them that are given to change. It's dangerous to us emotionally and spiritually to always be following someone who is never satisfied. Meddle comes from a Hebrew word which means *to braid, intermix, or mingled with*. The Hebrew word for change in Proverbs 24:21 means *to alter, disguise, or pervert*. Our English Dictionary defines change as *to become different, substitute or replace something*, and this one is interesting, *remove clothes and put on others*.

We can all agree that it is dangerous to follow people who are always changing what they stand for, love, indulge in, embrace, refrain from, pick up, put down, and the list can go on and on.

We must be constant in our stand and walk with the Lord. We cannot be one thing today and something else tomorrow. We cannot change with the wind of every doctrine. We cannot change with each new fad for fads with change again. We cannot change with the newest rage of religion for the newest rage will change again. We must be like Jesus, and the Bible says in Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

We should follow the One that never changes-Jesus! We should follow the teachings of the Book that never changes-the Bible! We should attend churches that we know are going to be the same Biblically based, solid, holy, and spirit-filled atmosphere year in and year out!

If every preacher, every saint, every Church would speak the same thing, stand for the same thing, and do the same thing, there would not be souls confused about what is right and what is wrong.
