

Seeking Approval

2 Timothy 2:15-16 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. 16 But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

Approval is defined as: the belief that something or someone is good or acceptable: a good opinion of someone or something: permission to do something: acceptance of an idea,

action, plan, etc.

Approval, we all seek it, we all want it, and we all seek it from others, that is just how we are. We learn about seeking approval at a very early age. How many times has your child brought you a *drawing, crayon artwork, stick-figure-Picassos* to get a smile or a compliment of your approval that they did a great job? They want to know that what they have done is O.K.

What we must learn about seeking approval is to seek approval from the right people for the right reasons. Seeking the right approval from the right person can bring you much happiness and contentment, but seeking approval from the wrong person for the wrong purpose will bring you misery and heartache.

Paul gave Timothy sound advice in seeking approval—study the Word. Studying the Word will equip us to live a life pleasing and approved of God! Paul gave Timothy sound advice from whom to seek approval—God. Seeking the Will of God will keep you from the will of others and even our own will. For what we want to do, may not be what we need to do! Paul was helping Timothy understand what was really important--studying the

Word and getting the approval of God.

We must be careful in our day when it comes to seeking approval. If we are seeking approval to do something just because we want to do it, then we will seek out people who will agree with us and give us that approval or affirmation that will satisfy our hearts and minds.

Seeking approval to do something just because it looks good, sounds good, and is what we want to do, doesn't mean that it is the right thing to do.

Paul wanted Timothy to learn from Him, and experience the wonderful and powerful things of God. Paul wanted Timothy to always seek God's approval. Paul warned Timothy about his youth and to not get caught up in youthful things that can seek approval from the wrong sources.

In closing, God's approval will give us direction for our lives and the lives of those we influence. So be careful when seeking approval from a friend, coworker, or even another saint of God, and ask yourself: *Is what I want approval to do, approved of God.*" Remember, Eve found someone (satan) who gave their approval for her to eat of the tree that God said to stay away from.
