#### More Than Just A Child

John 5:39-40 "Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life."

Many only view Jesus as just another child. Their concept of Him only deals with the natural and therefore they can only accept His humanity. Some accept Jesus as only a great man ranking with John the Baptist or other prophets of old. But was Jesus just a man or is He more?
