

I Corinthians 13:13 And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.

Charity in I Corinthians 13 is not what most people think of when they hear this word. Most people think of charity as the act of kindness in helping someone with material or financial needs. But in I Corinthians 13, charity is referring to a love that is more than just giving. Charity is translated from the Greek Word agapē, which refers to the highest form of love—a selfless love. We see it again John 15:13 Greater love (agapē) hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
