Encouragement, Strong As Nails!

Isaiah 41:6-7 They helped every one his neighbour; and every one said to his brother, Be of good courage. 7 So the carpenter encouraged the goldsmith, and he that smootheth with the hammer him that smote the anvil, saying, It is ready for the sodering; and he fastened it with nails, that it should not be moved.

Isaiah 41 begins with God encouraging His people. That's the God we serve! The God of encouragement, is

encouraging His people not to fear. And through this encouragement, it inspired God's people to encourage one another. The **"...carpenter encouraged the goldsmith, and he that smootheth with the hammer him that smote the anvil, saying, It is ready for the sodering; and he fastened it with nails, that it should not be moved."**
