The Prince Of Peace

Isaiah 9:6 (KJV Strong's) 6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

St. Francis de Sales once said, "Never be in a hurry; do everything quietly and in a calm spirit. Do not lose your inner peace for anything whatsoever, even if your whole world seems upset." There is a song that says, "...*peace, peace, wonderful peace, coming down from the*

Father above. Sweep over my soul forever I pray, In fanthomless billows of love...".
