## YOUR ABIB

***Exodus 12:1&2 "And the Lord spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you."***

Israel had been in bondage in Egypt but they were about to be severed from Egypt's grip! Their past was going to be just that--the past, and they were about to enter into a new phase of their lives. They were going to march out of Egypt and it's influences and march into the miraculous! On the other side of the Red Sea lay a new beginning. And again in Exodus 34:18 The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: **for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.** And once again in Deuteronomy 16:1 we read: Observe the month of Abib, and keep the passover unto the LORD thy Go: **for in the month of Abib the**

**LORD thy God brought thee forth out of Egypt by night.**

In the midst of all that has happened in your past with disappointments, heartaches, and setbacks, and all this COVID-19 mess, we can break out of our past, and experience a true new beginning in the Lord. We can let go of the past and reach forth to greater heights as we seize the opportunities that lay ahead.
