### *CAC Sunday School Reboot*

Exodus 15:23-27 And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they were bitter: therefore the name of it was called Marah. 24 And the people murmured against Moses, saying, What shall we drink? 25 And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD shewed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them, 26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his

sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.

The waters were not safe to drink because the waters were bitter. The water was wet, but undrinkable. The water looked like water but was unsafe to drink. So, this water needed a reboot! After Moses talked to the Lord, the Lord showed Moses a tree that would change the water from bitter to sweet, from unsafe to safe. Moses did as the Lord instructed him and the water was restored to usefulness.

Have you ever had to reboot your computer? Perhaps it was sluggish or “locked up” and quit responding to your mouse and keyboard commands, so you had to shut it down and start it back up again, which resulted in it being restored to working properly. You just performed a reboot.

Webster’s defines *reboot* as: to shut down and restart; to start up again after closing or shutting down; to boot up again; to start (something) anew : to refresh (something) by

making a new start or creating a new version. Today we are doing a CAC Sunday School Reboot!

In March of this year, Covid-19 became such a concern by the medical community that they advised all businesses, churches, and large gatherings to be halted until they could see what could be done to stop the spread of this potentially deadly disease. So, CAC followed the recommendations and shut down our Services, Youth Service, and Sunday School. CAC Staff performed online teaching, Church Services, and tried new ways to stay connected and still minister to all ages. While this was good in its place, we realized that we needed to reboot our Services, Sunday School, and Youth Department to effectively reach our community and surrounding areas.

Today, the first time since March, we are having our Sunday School Department go back in the classrooms and officially have Sunday School at CAC. We are rebooting—starting back up after closing—Sunday School at CAC!
