On July 13, 1997, we opened the doors

of a church plant at Mouthcard, Kentucky with the name given to the Church as Cornerstone Apostolic Church. We were renting a building at the time and we desired to have an established work, so we set out to find land to purchase and build.

The Church voted to buy this tract of land at Jamboree, Kentucky. We had groundbreaking on May 9, 1998 and then entered into a building program.

Within 4 months from Groundbreaking, we had our first service in the finished Sanctuary on September 27, 1998. Under advisement of other pastors and leaders, who advised us to have several services in the new building before we had the Dedication Service, we followed that godly advice and we held our Dedication Service on October 18, 1998. This is why we have Anniversary Service in July to celebrate when we started and Homecoming in October to celebrate the Dedication of the building and facilities that we now call home to Cornerstone Apostolic Church.

As we celebrate Homecoming 2020, we rejoice in what the Lord has done in using you precious people over the past 23 years to help Cornerstone Apostolic Church excel to be a place where the hurting, the backslider, and the lost could find a place of refuge, healing, and salvation.
