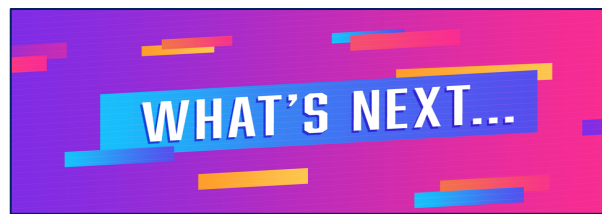

***Obtaining Every Possible Benefit
From The Word***

II Timothy 3:16-17 “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of

God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.”

The verses above let us know the purpose of the Word of God. We see that the Word is given by inspiration of God. It is not man inspired. It is God inspired. We also see that the Word of God is profitable. When you think of something profitable, you think of *something that gives or brings you gain*. You may think of something that benefits you. You may think of profitable as something that *gets you more*. If something is profitable, it doesn't necessarily mean that it gives you something **once**, to me, it means that you **keep getting** from something that is profitable.

Just take your bank account for instance. When you open a Savings Account, you start to earn interest on the money that is placed in the account. This interest doesn't just happen once and then stop, but this interest keeps building and building. It is a continual process of gaining from something that is already in the account.

Just as we see this natural illustration, we can see the spiritual illustration of how the Word of God gives us *gain*, not just once, but continually. The more we read the more we *gain*. The more we read, the more we *get* from what we read. It's a continual process of knowledge and blessings.

The Word of God is something that you can get more out of each time that you read it. You may read a Scripture today and get some *nugget of value* for your situation and then read the same Scripture sometime later and get a different *nugget* for a totally different situation.

That's why it is important that we consistently read the Word of God. Reading the Word once is good, but to obtain every possible benefit of the Word, you have to read it over and over. You have to think upon the Word that you have just read. Scriptures have to be gone over and over for us to get the full benefit of them.

If you want to receive the full benefits that the Word can give, then you are going to have to read the Word over and over. To consistently obtain every possible benefit, we have to consistently dedicate ourselves to the study of the Word. With each new time we read the Word, there is a new blessing waiting.
