# Where Are You Placing Your Confidence?

Psalms 27:1-3 "The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear:



## though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident."

David's confidence wasn't placed in his kingdom, although the kingdom that David ruled was a great one. His confidence wasn't placed in the military ability of the kingdom, although that army was well-trained, well-equipped, and very competent. Neither was David's confidence placed in his own abilities or accomplishments, and what accomplishments and abilities David had!

David's confidence was in a higher King from a higher Kingdom! David's confidence was in the Lord!! David knew it didn't matter what he had at his disposal, it would all be useless without the Lord's blessing. David knew it was the Lord who made his kingdom successful and his armies triumphant. No one else could take the credit! No one else could get the glory!

David's confidence was in the One who was able to protect when outnumbered--deliver when surrounded by destruction--and secure even when there seemed to be no security! David knew who it was that put him in the kingdom and that was where his confidence remained.

We today must place our confidence in the Lord. Everything that we have accomplished or ever will accomplish, we have to acknowledge it was the Lord who made it

possible. Because we have placed our confidence in the Lord, we don't have to worry about the outcome. If we truly have placed it all in His hands, then we can stand with confidence that *Who* our confidence is in, will see us through.
