

## THE LOVE FOR GOD AND THE LOVE FOR MAN

Once a lawyer asked Jesus a question concerning what commandment is the greatest. Jesus answered him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. Jesus told him that this is the first and great commandment. And then

Jesus went on to tell him the second great commandment, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

We find from the words of Jesus that on these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. Simply put, we must love the Lord *and* we must love our fellow man.

Many folks today don't have a problem when it comes to loving the Lord, the problem comes when you ask them to love others. But in all reality, you can't love the Lord if you don't love others. And this also works in the opposite you can't love others if you don't love the Lord.

The sad part of our society today is that many church folk can't love one another. Many pastors can't love one another. Many Christians walk right past one another without even speaking. What a disappointment it must be to the Lord to see His children acting this way. If we can't display love, genuine love before this lost and dying world, we will not be able to help others see their need of serving Jesus. In reality, if we can't love one another, we can't serve Jesus.
