## THE LOVE FOR GOD AND THE LOVE FOR MAN

Once a lawyer asked Jesus a question concerning what commandment is the greatest. Jesus answered him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. Jesus told him that this is the first and great commandment. And then Jesus went on to tell him the second great



commandment, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
