## Every Thing Has A Right Time

**Ecclesiastes 3:1 “To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:”**

Webster's Dictionary says a season is "...a time characterized by a particular circumstance or feature; a period associated with some phase or activity; a period normally characterized by a

particular kind of weather...” One definition that is particularly interesting is that of “...at the right time...”

So with this understanding, we can see how Ecclesiastes 3:1 reveals to us that every thing has a *right time*. Have you ever heard someone, when they experience something good say, “The time was right for me?” Maybe it was when they changed jobs. Maybe it was when they changed where they lived. Maybe it was when they changed the direction in which their lives were headed. Do you notice that *change* is often associated with the *right time*?

Seasons not only mean a right time, but it also means a time of change. Many times, we see change happening in the Bible. Not a change of Doctrine, standards, or authority of the Word, but a change in times and circumstances. To try to change His Word is something very dangerous, because His Word is forever settled in Heaven. (Ps. 119:89) Revelation 22:18-19 warns, For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book. So to try to change the Word of God is certain disaster. There is *never*

a right time to change the Word of God. Jesus gave the illustration to us that now is the right time for harvest. Harvest is a time of change. You go from growing the crop to harvesting the crop. And Jesus said in John 4:35-37 Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest. And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together. And herein is that saying true, One soweth, and another reapeth.

The time is right for a change! The time is right for a harvest? Is the time right for you to change?
