Birthdays

Birthdays are mentioned three times in the Bible, but two of the times is referencing the same incident. Let's read, **Genesis 40:20-22** which says, **And it came to pass the third day, which was Pharaoh's birthday, that he made a feast unto all his servants: and he lifted up the head of the chief butler and of**

the chief baker among his servants. 21 And he restored the chief butler unto his butlership again; and he gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand: 22 But he hanged the chief baker: as Joseph had interpreted to them. And let's also read, Matthew 14:6-10 But when Herod's birthday was kept, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod. 7 Whereupon he promised with an oath to give her whatsoever she would ask. 8 And she, being before instructed of her mother, said, Give me here John Baptist's head in a charger. 9 And the king was sorry: nevertheless for the oath's sake, and them which sat with him at meat, he commanded it to be given her. 10 And he sent, and beheaded John in the prison.

I don't know what if anything this says about Birthdays, but we see what happened on these two occasions, the Butler was hanged, and John the Baptist was beheaded.

Well, yesterday, February 27th was my Birthday. I turned 63 years old and celebrated quietly at home by giving thanks to the Lord for another year.

My Birthday not only commemorates the day that I was born, but it also commemorates the day I preached my first message, February 27, 1982. That was 39 years ago! Wow, where has
