### Jesus' Triumphal Entry Our Palm Sunday

Matthew 21:1-9 "And when they drew nigh unto Jerusalem, and were come to Bethphage, unto the mount of Olives, then sent Jesus two disciples, Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose them, and bring them



unto me. And if any man say ought unto you, ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them, and straightway he will send them. All this was done, that it might be fulfilled the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass. And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them, And brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set Him thereon. And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way. And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest."

As we view this scene, we see Jesus' triumphal entry into the city of Jerusalem. Here we can feel the excitement and expectation of the people. Some are spreading their garments in the way, some are cutting branches of trees and spreading them in the way, and others are rejoicing, praising God, and crying: "...Hosanna..." which means: "save or help now". The crowd was jubilant, thinking possibly the hour of deliverance was at hand. But what became of this jubilation in the days that followed?

We see a drastic change from the praise and

rejoicing to a scene of rejection and anger! One day we see praise and cries of Hosanna, another day we see rejection and cries of crucify Him!

What a difference a few days make. Everything can be exciting and full of expectation, and the next can be disappointing and full of doubt. We sometimes forget Jesus' triumphal entry into our lives and the joy and jubilation He brought! Don't let the problems and challenges of the day distract or disturb you, let Jesus ride into your life and restore joy and jubilation!
