

### For Show Or For Service

Luke 18:10-14 "Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee,

that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted."

When Jesus spoke this parable to the people, He established the difference between *show* and *service*. If you notice, the Pharisee went to the temple—he went to church, but it was just for a show. Notice that the Pharisee even prayed, but his prayers were nothing more than *self-pats-on-the-back* of pride. Notice that the Pharisee was more concerned about mentioning what he does instead of praying. The Pharisee never grasped the true meaning of service.

Show and service are two different things. Things that are done for show presents <u>self</u>. Things that are done for service present <u>sacrifice</u>. Things that are done for show produces <u>pride</u>. Things that are done for service produces <u>humbleness</u>. Things that are done for service produces <u>humbleness</u>. Things that are done for show <u>has to have recognition</u>. Things that are done for service <u>needs no recognition</u>. You can go to church for a show or you can go to church for service. You can pray for a show

or you can pray in service. You can tithe for a show or you can tithe for service. You can fast for show or you can fast for service.

Folks must constantly be on guard to never do anything for show. The Bible tells us in *Proverbs 16:18-19 "Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud."* So those who only do things for a show will eventually meet destruction, because a show produces pride. Those who do things for a show will eventually fall, because putting on a show produces a haughty spirit.

Don't put on an act, don't put on a show, just do service for Him, and He "...shall reward thee openly." (Matthew 6:4,6,18)
