

Father's Day!

Exodus 20:12 "Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee."

Today is the day that we honor Dads. While almost anyone can father a child, it takes more than biological connections to be a father. We find the supreme example of what a father is found in the Scriptures--God's relationship to His children.

So what does it take to be a dad? It takes love, and lots of it. It takes understanding, and once again lots of it. It takes the willingness to provide, and yes (as your children constantly let you know) lots of it.

Dads are the head of the household and always keeps the well-being of the family in mind. A good dad will sacrifice things for himself just so his family can have the necessary provisions.

A dad is more than a provider, he must be an instructor and disciplinarian. There are times when a dad will have to correct his children by instruction and sometimes by *belt-struction*.
