CAN WE DIRECT PEOPLE TO JESUS

In John chapter 1 and verse 41, we find Andrew, who was one of the first disciples to

follow Jesus after hearing John speak, bringing his brother to Jesus. Andrew would soon find out that his actions of bringing his brother to Jesus would present to the Church one of the greatest workers for the Lord recorded in the Bible.

Andrew, whom little is mentioned and known about, did something that had a magnificent impact upon the early church. For you see, Andrew's brother was none other than Peter. That's right, the same Peter that stood on the day of Pentecost and proclaimed in Acts 2:38 the plan of salvation. The same Peter who people just wanted his shadow to pass over them, the same Peter who was part of the inner circle that Jesus gave some of His most intricate details of who He was and the work He came to do. And yes, this is the same Peter that denied the Lord three times.

When we look at Peter's life, we see an ordinary man who was used in extraordinary ways. And we must be willing to lead our co-workers to Jesus. Who knows, the next person you lead to Jesus may be a great Preacher, a great Pastor, or a great Sunday School Teacher. You never know, the next person you lead to Jesus could be the next Deacon, choir director, Sunday School Supt, singer, musician. The next person you lead to Jesus could be the next missionary.
