### Sing Praises!

***Psalms 47:6-7 "Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding."***

Why do people sing? Various answers can be predicated, but most often, singing tells a story. Singing is sort of a testimony that is placed to music! Singing expresses the feelings of the singer!

The very first mention of *song* in the Bible is found in Exodus the 15th chapter. Here we find Moses and the Children of Israel singing about how the Lord delivered them out of the hand of pharaoh! And guess where we find the last mention of singing in the Bible? It is found in Revelation the 15th chapter! And guess what is being sung? The Song Of Moses, the same song that was first sung in Exodus the 15th chapter! Just think, the first song recorded is in Exodus, a book of "departure", and the last song recorded in the Bible is in Revelation, another book of "departure"! And get this, both times, the song is found in the 15th chapter of the respective Books!

All of us have victories that the Lord has given us when we were facing a battle or circumstance. These situations present the opportunity for us to sing a new song unto the Lord for His deliverance. When we come through something victorious, we should sing some praises to the Lord! After all, what greater way to express your joy and your appreciation to the Lord for the victory, but by a song? What a testimony to others who hear your song of victory! You never know what

affect it is going to have on others—you never know what impact it is going to have on future generations when you sing about what God has done for you!

When we sing, let's sing praise unto the Lord. The focus of our song should be toward the Master. The essence of the song should be about His excellent power! Let's praise the Lord with song! Sing about His deliverances! Sing about His greatness! Sing praises unto Him!
