

In the book of Judges, we are told of a Nazarite by the name of Samson. As a Nazarite, there **a**

were standards set forth for him to follow before he was even born. In addition, Samson was not allowed to cut his hair. His miraculous physical strength was tied to his obedience. This was important for many reasons, one of them being that he was meant to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines. Samson began his journey blessed. He accomplished many feats that the Lord wanted him to do, but he soon became distracted from where God wanted him to be. This distraction came in the form of a Philistine woman. God had called Samson and all other Israelites to be separate from the Philistines, but Samson did not follow what God had set before him. Samson still had the physical strength that God gave him, but he began walking a dangerous path. It was clear that Samson had a problem with temptation from women. Each time he gave in to his temptations, it worsened. The third time this happened, he fell for a woman named Delilah. Delilah was determined to find the source of Samson's strength. Samson resisted Delilah at first by lying to her, but he never removed Delilah from his life. This ultimately led to his death.

If we leave our temptations unchecked and do not remove ourselves, then we are leaving ourselves open to attacks from the enemy. If Samson had removed Delilah from his life, then he would have never been captured, his hair never cut, and his strength never taken. We must be separate from the world and the temptations that could lead to our ruin, not spending our free time inviting the enemy in.
