### THE ATTRACTION OF A SPIRIT FILLED CHURCH

Acts 16:16-18 (KJV) 16 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: 17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of

salvation. 18 And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.

Have you ever noticed how quickly flies, ants, even animals are attracted to food left outside? Have you noticed how quickly you run to the kitchen when you smell the aroma of some favorite dish being prepared. This is because the food has an attraction quality.

A Spirit-filled Church has an attraction about it also. A Spirit-filled Church attracts both those who want a life change as well as those who don't want a life change. A Spirit-filled Church attracts those who want to help the Church and those who want to hurt the Church. A Spirit-filled Church attracts those who will give their life to the Lord and those who refuse to give their life to the Lord. A Spirit-filled Church attracts those who will help the Church move forward and those who will hold the Church back.

For you see, a Spirit-filled Church is Heaven blessed and Hell fought. But even if the attraction of the Church brings in an element of destruction, we have the assurance found in Matthew 16:18 (KJV) 18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I

will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

The Church is supposed to be a Spirit-filled Church. We are called to walk in the Spirit-- Galatians 5:16 (KJV) 16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

We are called to be filled with Spirit-- Ephesians 5:18 (KJV) 18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

No one can predict who will be drawn to you as an individual or to the Church collectively, but we know that a Spirit-filled church will draw— will have an attraction.

Let's continue to be a Spirit-filled Church! The world we live in needs the Church to be Spirit-filled! Let's attract, both good and bad and win them both to Jesus.
