When Your Back Is Against The Wall

Romans 4:18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

Abraham believed in hope when there was

no natural grounds for hope. Abraham cherished the expectation of what was promised to him by the Lord. Even when it looked impossible, Abraham held onto the expectation of hope and believed God.

Have you ever felt like you were backed in a corner and trapped? Have you ever felt like your back was against the wall and that there was nowhere to turn? Sometimes we all face circumstances or situations that make us feel this way. Sometimes we feel like there is just *no way* our situation is going to improve or turn around.

Well, in times like these, you must learn how to handle the situation when you are against the wall. When it seems that all is hopeless and all odds are against you, then you must be like Abraham who against hope believed in hope. You must cherish and hold onto the expectation of hope. You must be like Abraham and not give up when things look hopeless, believe in hope. Abraham still had faith that things were going to come to pass even when it looked impossible.

The difference between folks who give up and folks who stand depends upon their hope! If their hope is founded only by what they see, then it is not really hope at all. But if their hope is grounded in faith, then they walk by that faith and hold onto real hope. Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

So faith believes that what you can't see is going to come to pass. If you can see it, it's not faith, it's sight. And the Bible tells us in II Corinthians 5:7 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:).

When you find yourself against a wall, stand tall in faith, don't lose hope, faith will let you move forward even when your back is against the wall! When folks become stranded in life and death situations, the survivors will tell you that they survived because they kept moving forward. They will tell you that as long as they kept moving, they had hope of surviving.

When you feel like you can't go on, keep moving forward, you will survive—even when your back is against the wall.
