

There's Always A Response

<u>Psalms 31:24</u> "Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord."

There is always a response from the Lord when His people face a problem.

When the words were penned in Psalms 31,

they were penned as words of trusting in the Lord, more accurately songs of trust. David trusted in the Lord no matter what circumstances he faced. David knew that with each problem he faced, there was going to be an answer from Heaven. David knew that when he faced dangers, the Lord was going to give him a response. David knew that when he faced troubles, the Lord was going to respond to his troubles. David knew that when he faced grief or sorrow, the Lord was going to give a response to his situation. For you see, David knew that all answers were found in Lord.

When Jesus looked at Simon Peter and said, "...thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall no prevail against it. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatsoever thou shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.", He was letting him know that to every gate that hell has, there is a key to get through it. The word "gates" is plural meaning more than one, and the word "keys" is plural meaning more than one. So as you can see, for every gate that hell shuts, there's a key from Heaven to unlock it.

Notice that the keys were given to Peter by the Lord. Jesus was actually giving Peter responses to every situation that he would face. It didn't matter what the circumstance, there was a key-

a response.

When we face our problems today, we need to realize that the Lord has given us keys for the gates we face! He will give us a response for every circumstance or situation that we face. We don't face anything that He doesn't know we are going through. We don't face anything too hard for Him to help us out of. We just need to learn how to respond before the response. We have to learn how to be of good courage when we don't know the outcome of a situation. We have to learn to hope in the Lord when we face circumstances beyond our control. In responding this way, we will find a response from the Lord, addressing our individual circumstances, because there's always a response from the Lord!
