Sometimes It Is All In Your Mind

James 1:8 “A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.”

What does it mean to be *double minded*? In the Greek, the word for *double minded* is *dipsuchos* (*dip'-soo-khos*) which means *two-spirited, such as indecisive or wavering in opinion or purpose*. When a person is *double minded*, they seem to have two different *minds*.

When a person is *double minded*, they say one thing and do another. They become so unstable that nothing they do or say makes sense. In fact, they are so indecisive that they can't even make rational decisions. Everything about their life seems to be chaotic. Every which way they turn they find themselves in trouble. They want to do better, they want to do good, but because they are *double minded*, they can't seem to *get it together*.

When a person is *double minded*, their life is filled with inconsistencies. Nothing they attempt has any constant value. They are inconsistent in their actions. They are inconsistent in their opinions. Inconsistency becomes a noticeable characteristic that displays itself in incoherent and unintelligible ways.

When someone is *double minded*, they end up on a journey to destruction. They destroy their own lives as well as those lives around them. They lose interest in work. They lose interest in family. They lose interest in Church. They lose interest in decency. A *double minded*

person doesn't fully comprehend the destructive path they are on, else they would turn around before it is too late.

What causes a person to become *double minded*? The plain and simple answer is SIN! **James 4:8** says: ***“Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.”*** When a person starts withdrawing from God, they are taking steps toward becoming *double minded*. When a person's mind becomes so cluttered with daily routines, and daily desires they soon become unfocused and confused. Their mind becomes unstable, and an unstable mind makes the entire body unstable.

Sometimes, it is all in your mind! Not a *made up* or *imagined* thing, but rather a real mind problem. The cure for double mindedness is found in **Mark 12:30** ***“And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.”***
