# Harvest Time Crusade 2021

<u>Joel 1:11-12</u> "Be ye ashamed, O ye husbandmen; howl, O ye vinedressers, for the wheat and for the barley; because the harvest of the field is perished. The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, even all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men."

What caused the Harvest to perish? The answer is found at the end of verse 12, "...because joy is withered away from the sons of men." Wow, what an awakening, their Harvest perished because their joy perished! There was nothing being produced in their fields, because no joy was being produced in their lives! Their vine dried up, because their joy dried up! Their fig tree languished because their joy languished! Their palm tree withered because their joy withered! And then we are reminded of the introduction of these verses which calls for them to be ashamed! Ashamed of what? Ashamed that they have let the Harvest perish! And then the call was for them to howl. In the Hebrew, we find howl (yalal, yaw-lal') to also mean to wail. A wail is an audible expression of sorrow. A wail is a loud prolonged cry expressing grief or pain.

We as the Church must be careful not to let our joy wither! If our joy withers, then our Harvest will wither. The Harvest is directly connected to our joy. If there is no Harvest, then that means that nothing is coming in. If we want our loved ones to come in, then we must have joy! Nobody wants to come to a place where no joy is. Folks that are out in the world are looking for a place to get away from a *joyless* lifestyle! And the only way the Church is going to have a positive impact upon others is to have the joy of the Lord present and displayed!

Wouldn't it be a sad thing to miss-out-on a tremendous Harvest simply because we lost our joy? Wouldn't it be a *shame* for the Harvest to wither because we let jealousy and strife steal our joy? Wouldn't it be terrible to find ourselves *howling* in despair because our families and friends are not interested in salvation, and it was directly related to our lives being vacant of joy?

If you want to see a Harvest, don't lose your joy, if you lose your joy, then you will lose the Harvest.
