Why There Should Never Be Backsliders

Proverbs 14:14 (KJV) 14 The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways: and a good man shall be satisfied from himself.

What is a backslider? What can a person do to avoid backsliding? And if a person finds

themselves in a backslidden condition, is there any hope of recovery or restoration? These are all questions that need good, solid, Biblical answers. Let's look deeper into these.

What is a backslider? It is defined as a going back, turning aside, and withdrawing from obeying the Lord. It is what happens when you turn away from God and go *back* to living in sin. Hosea 4:16 says *For Israel slideth back as a backsliding heifer: now the LORD will feed them as a lamb in a large place.* This reference is like when a stubborn cow (heifer) won't stay in the herd and keeps straying off and won't listen to the cattle herder. As Proverbs 14:14 states, *"The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways:..."* which reveals backsliding is a heart condition that leads to rebellion against God's Word.

What can a person do to avoid backsliding? This is probably one of the simplest answers that can be given—simply get back up and keep following the Lord. Sounds too easy right? What does the Bible say about getting back up when you have fallen? Micah 7:8 *Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD shall be a light unto me.* To avoid backsliding, you have to keep getting back up, dusting yourself off, repent for the failure, and continue—yes continue following and obey the Lord. If folks would do this, there would be no backsliders.

If a person finds themselves in a backslidden condition, is there any hope of recovery or restoration? And the answer is yes! Jeremiah 3:14-15 *Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD; for I am married unto you: and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and I will bring you to Zion: 15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.* And Hosea 14:4 gives great assurance, *Verse 4 I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for mine anger is turned away from him.* The Lord loves you and He wants you to be saved! He wants you to get back up! He wants to keep serving Him! 2 Peter 3:9 says, *The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.*
