## Something Good Out Of The Storm

Psalms 107:25-32 "For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof. They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble. They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wit's end. Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses. He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven. Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders."

Storms, as Webster's Dictionary defines them, are: a disturbance of the atmosphere marked by wind and usually by rain, snow, hail, sleet, or thunder and lightening; a disturbed or agitated state.

Storms are usually an *un-welcomed* intruder. I use the word intruder because I don't know of anybody that stands on the shore and looks out to an oncoming hurricane and welcomes the storm into their neighborhood and lives. Why? And in order to survive the storm, we have to be prepared for the storm! We have to learn to recover from the storm. How do I do that? By having the knowledge of the Scriptures. The Bible is a Book of preparing! It will get you ready for the storm, inform you how to survive the storm, and help you recover from the storm. One of the greatest things we can remember in the time of storm is that the Lord is in charge of the storm. He can raise the stormy wind to accomplish His good pleasure and then bring that stormy wind to a complete calm. The Lord can be a Storm-Raiser, and a Storm-Calmer.

The next time you face a storm, maybe there are some things that need recycled or purged in your life. And maybe the storm is going to have a positive influence on your life. Who knows, you may even find yourself a better person after the storm.
