



Now What?

Exodus 4:10-16 And Moses said unto the LORD, O my Lord, I am not eloquent, neither heretofore, nor since thou hast spoken unto thy servant: but I am slow of speech, and of a slow tongue. 11 And the LORD said unto him, Who hath made man's mouth? or who maketh

the dumb, or deaf, or the seeing, or the blind? have not I the LORD? 12 Now therefore go, and I will be with thy mouth, and teach thee what thou shalt say. 13 And he said, O my Lord, send, I pray thee, by the hand of him whom thou wilt send. 14 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, Is not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart. 15 And thou shalt speak unto him, and put words in his mouth: and I will be with thy mouth, and with his mouth, and will teach you what ye shall do. 16 And he shall be thy spokesman unto the people: and he shall be, even he shall be to thee instead of a mouth, and thou shalt be to him instead of God.

Have you ever felt inadequate? Feel like you could never do what others seem to do with such ease? Feeling like you don't fit in? Maybe feeling like you don't know what to do next?

Moses was a man who felt inadequate. He felt like he wasn't good enough or talented enough to fulfil what God called him to do, for most scholars have concluded, Moses had a stutter.

What Moses didn't realize was, God wasn't looking at his inabilities, He was looking for a leader. And God wasn't going to let Moses off

the hook just because he felt verbally challenged. God gave Moses a helper, his brother Aaron, to be the orator that Moses felt he wasn't.

Now back to you. Have you ever felt inadequate to do a job? Maybe someone ask you to speak to a Youth Group, but you felt you weren't someone who could impact young people. Maybe someone asked you to start a P7 Club at your school, but you thought someone else would be better than you. Maybe the Lord brought a friend into your life that didn't know anything about salvation, and simply wanted you to teach them a Bible Study, but you passed on this life-changing opportunity.

When God calls you to do a job, He wants YOU. Not someone else, not someone more talented, not someone more influential, not someone with more abilities—God wants YOU!

Don't let your challenges, physically or mentally, keep you from answering the call of God. If God calls you, He will equip you! God wants YOU FOR YOU, just as you are, failures, scars, insecurities, and all—God wants you—Now What?
