Isaiah 6:8 (KJV) 8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.

Isaiah didn't hesitate to volunteer. He didn't

even ask about what he was expected to do. He just replied, *"Here am I; send me."* True volunteerism doesn't ask about the job and then volunteer, they volunteer first.

Volunteerism is the backbone of many organizations.
