Are You A Pentecostal?

Acts 2:1-4 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Pentecost Sunday is the Christian celebration of 50 days after Easter celebrating the outpouring

of the Holy Ghost in the Upper Room on the 120 on the Day of Pentecost. It is also a celebration of the birth of the Church.

Pentecostal is not a denomination it is the Church! If you are part of the Church that was birthed in that upper room where folks were drunk but not as they supposed; and all began to speak with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance you have no choice but to be Pentecostal.

If you are going to be part of that powerful, blood bought Church of Jesus Christ, then you will be Pentecostal!

Pentecost is a noun, for it was an event, Pentecostal even though it can be a noun, can also be used as an adjective that is defined as, “of, relating to, or suggesting Pentecost”. So, therefore, to be Pentecostal means that we know our beginning as a Church by relating it to the Day of Pentecost.

Someone once said, “Pentecost is not a denomination, it is an experience” and how true that is, we have an experience as Christians that defines us as Pentecostal.

Are you a Pentecostal? If you want to be a part of the Church, then you must experience what the first “members” experienced! Repent, get baptized in Jesus Name, and get filled with the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in

other tongues, and then you too can be a Pentecostal!
